## **IMPORTANT ALERT ABOUT SPUDNICK AND COVID-19 VIRUS**

### **SPUDNICK TONIGHT CHANGED TO TAKE-OUT**

For those residents who purchased tickets to tonight's Spudnick event, the in-the-clubhouse event has been changed to a take-out only. Beginning at 7:00 PM, residents who purchased tickets may pick up their "take-out" dinner at the clubhouse. Thank you for your understanding and patience. And thanks to this committee for being flexible and sensitive to the current health crisis.

### **ALERT: Covid-19 Virus**

This is to address inquiries relating to the Covid-19 Virus as it relates to the use of the clubhouse and attending classes, meetings, and activities. While Governor Brown's recent order does not apply to Summerplace as we do not have any group events over 250 people, residents should do what they think is best for their personal situation and health when deciding whether to attend.

The Activity or Event chair, not the Board, is responsible for making the decision to hold or cancel a scheduled activity/event and they will be the one to communicate such a decision. We ask that the HOA Office be notified of all cancellations so that in addition to the communication from the chair, the information can be posted on the clubhouse bulletin board and website.

If you do come to the Clubhouse, please keep a "social distance" of at least 3 feet from another person (no handshakes, hugs, etc.). We continue with our regularly scheduled Clubhouse cleaning which includes disinfecting common touch points and have hand sanitizer available throughout the clubhouse. Please keep in mind that regardless of this cleaning, once someone touches a surface it is no longer "clean" and we all need to be washing our hands frequently and avoid touching our faces. There are twelve sinks in the Clubhouse that can be used.

If you have a fever, please do not come to the Clubhouse for at least two weeks and seek appropriate medical attention.

If we hear of a confirmed case of Covid-19 virus in Summerplace, we will send out another email and we will post on our website homepage, [www.summerplacehoa.com](http://www.summerplacehoa.com) <<http://www.summerplacehoa.com>>. Please check the website announcements for other updates.
