### Stay at Home Order

Governor Kate Brown earlier today issued a Stay at Home Order. This affects all of us. You may continue to exercise outdoors, but if you walk with a companion or encounter someone while walking, please keep at least six feet distance between individuals.

Marilyn Frost and Bob Kravitz have stepped up to organize a group of volunteers who will pick up groceries or prescriptions for those of our residents who are unable to do so for themselves. And if you have neighbors who do not use computers/email communications, please pass along this message.

Our office staff and Bill Cave, our custodian, have been instructed to remain home until this order is lifted by the governor. We want to assure residents that Peg, Dory, and Bill will continue to receive their regular compensation during this health crisis. We do not want to financially penalize them for a problem not of their making.
